*Texoir is a single varietal project, showcasing vineyards planted to the warm climate grape varieties that thrive in the unforgiving Texas High Plains a.v.a.*

*Vintage: 2017 was thinned by early hail, then followed by record rain fall for this area, leaving us with one of the best vintages in recent years.*

*Varietal: Carignan is a late ripening grape that loves the hot and arid conditions of the Texas High Plains. This vintage of Carignan spoke volumes of what makes this growing region special, and makes perfect sense that we chose it for the inaugural release.*

*Taste: Fleshy, currant, plum and raspberry, underlined with beautiful, herbal notes. Bright acidity cuts into a core of earth and spicebox, that blows in like the West Texas wind.*
