VINTAGE: 2018 = RECORD LOW WINTER TEMPERATURES LED TO A VERY HOT AND ARID SPRING, CAUSING LOW FRUIT SET. LATE SUMMER RAINS CAME IN TO EASE STRESS AND DELIVER GREAT CONCENTRATION ON LOW YIELDS.

OUR GOAL FROM THE FIRST RELEASE WAS TO MAKE PROVENCE-INSPIRED, DRY ROSÉ USING SIMILAR WARM CLIMATE VARIETALS GROWN IN THE TEXAS HIGH PLAINS AVA. FOR OUR SEVENTH VINTAGE, WE PICKED MOURVEDRE, ADDING SOME SMALL LOTS OF CINSAULT AND GRENACHE.

TASTE: THE FAINT PINK EXPRESSIONS ARE DECIEVING WHEN A BLAST OF RED FRUIT COMES AT YOU ON THE NOSE. THE MOURVEDRE OFFERS A VERY LUSH MOUTHFEEL OF JUICY RIPE CHERRY AND STRAWBERRY, WHILE THE GRENACHE AND CINSAULT BRING FINESSE FOR THE DRY, LINGERING FINISH.
