## 2018 MOURVEDRE

*Texoir is a single varietal project, showcasing vineyards planted to the warm climate grape varieties that thrive in the unforgiving Texas High Plains a.v.a.*

*Vintage: 2018 Record low winter temps led into a very hot and arid Spring causing low fruit set. Late Summer rains came in to ease vine stress and deliver great concentration on low yields.*

*Varietal: Mourvedre, also known as Mataro or Monastrell in Spain, is typically late budding and ripening, allowing it to perform well on the warm and arid High Plains.*

*Taste: A lustrous core of blackberry and plum, laced with floral notes of lavender and violets, that eventually give way to hints of sandalwood and mocha, finishing on fine-grained tannin. The allure of this wine lies in the balance of its rusticity and elegance.*
